


# Lantern



Make a paper Lantern to hold an LED lamp.



## YOU WILL NEED:



Lantern template, printed onto A4 paper or thin card,  
Lantern support template, printed onto card.  
LED Tea light  
Paper glue  
Scissors  
(Colouring pencils, felt tips or paint)


## SAFETY:

Take care not to cut yourself with the scissors.  
Do not dismantle the tea light.

## MAKING the LANTERN

1).	Cut off the unshaded strips on the edges of the template. Keep the wider strip - it can be used as a handle.	
2).	Apply any colour or designs to your lantern.	
3).	Fold the template in half length wise.	
4).	Carefully cut along each of the red lines from the fold.	
5).	Unfold and apply glue to strip B.	
6).	Curl the lantern round and carefully stick strip B underneath strip A.	
7).	Leave to dry.	
If the LED lamp is not needed, then the wider strip of paper from (1) can be glued to the top of the lantern to form a handle.		
8).	Cut out a lamp container and cut along the red lines.	

9).	<p>Carefully fold along the dotted lines of the lamp container and glue the flaps to the inside.          (A stapler can be used to secure the flaps, while the glue dries).          This forms an open box approximately 4cm x 4cm x 2cm.</p>		
10).	<p>Cut out the two supports and fold along the dotted lines.</p>		
11).	<p>Put glue on the shaded support surface, and stick the other support on top to form a U shaped frame approximately 7.5cm x 15.5cm.</p>		
12).	<p>Slide the U shaped frame into the lantern and glue the top of the U to the top of the lantern.</p>		
13).	<p>Carefully slide the bottom of the lantern UP the frame and glue the lamp container to the inside of the frame.</p>		
14).	<p>Cut out the handle and glue it to the top of the frame/lantern to form a handle.</p>		
15).	<p>Slide the lantern UP the frame and put the LED tea light into the lamp holder.</p>
